Deanery Schools Work Co-ordinator

The Deanery of Jersey Board of Finance (DJBF) is seeking to appoint a part time (approx 20 hours) **Schools Work Co-ordinator** across the Church of England Churches in the Deanery of Jersey.

As part of the Deanery of Jersey Strategy of "Making Jesus Known", the successful candidate will be a person of faith, who is comfortable working across the broad spectrum of the traditions of the Church of England in Jersey, who will develop a strategy of engaging with schools across the Island, by equipping and supporting, signposting and resourcing parish and district churches in their ministry and mission with their local schools and school children.

They will help inspire and encourage clergy and lay people to engage with their school community, by offering them training and providing 'practical' and 'people' resources for assisting with R.E lessons, collective worship and school clubs.

Working with established and new teams, they will develop a programme of one-off events for school children (both at primary and secondary, where appropriate), such as Life Expo, Christian festivals etc and develop a team across the Deanery churches to deliver them.

The successful candidate will already have relevant experience of working with schools in Christian education. They will be someone who can work with a team but also under their own initiative and who will engage with the wider education sector in the Island and education department where appropriate.

This is a flexible role (approx 20 hours per week), reporting to the Deanery Executive Secretary and meeting regularly with the Dean on a quarterly basis. A package is available for a 5-year contract, with a review after 3 years, subject to the usual criteria.
